The Public Lands Policy Coordinating Office received the following supplemental comments from Utah Geological Survey (UGS) concerning the potential geologic hazards that could affect the site.

The Applicant should address the potential hazards of seiche and earthquake-induced tsunami due to the proposed landfill's proximity to Great Salt Lake. Some carbonate bedrock exists in the area. The Applicant should address also the potential hazards associated with fractures and karst features. UGS recommends adequate protection to prevent liquid leakage towards the lake in fractured carbonate.
